



Somerton SLSC - Board & Ski Storage Policy

The storage areas in the Club are a valuable club resource. The need to store personal and club owned craft is at a premium demand. This policy outlines the process for members to request and be allocated space to store personal craft (board or ski).

Application Process

Members will be required to email the Club Captain clubcaptain@somertonsurfclub.com.au and request space for their board and/or ski.

Applicant Criteria

Applicants must meet the basic eligibility criteria to obtain a craft space:

- Be a current (min of 12 months) member of the club
- Be a proficient SRC or Bronze Medallion holder (or greater)
- Be no more than 8 hours down on their patrol obligation
- Be actively and regularly competing in SLSSA Craft specific events
- Be regularly participating in club sanctioned craft related training sessions (minimum once / week)
- Age priority: Youth/Seniors/Masters
- Other significant contributions to the Club

Conditions of Use

The Board & Ski Captain will allocate craft storage based on eligibility criteria. Successful applicants are entitled to ONE storage space per craft type (board/ski) and are responsible for the safe storage of their craft in their allocated space/s. Members who have allocated storage are to clearly identify their craft. Storage is strictly allocated to the nominated members craft only and cannot be transferred to another member.

*The Club takes no responsibility for damage or theft of personal craft stored at the Club.

Allocations will be under constant review with annual renewal required at the start of each membership year.

- Any applicant that does not meet the eligibility criteria may be asked to rectify the non-compliant issue within 7 days or remove the craft as soon as possible.
- At the start of each membership year, members will be reminded of their craft renewal. Once the fee has been paid the occupant will be reallocated their existing storage.

Fees

Craft Storage Fees (as at 23/09/2025): \$0 per annum.

NOTE: This fee is subject to change at the discretion of the Board.

If payment is not received within one month of the application being approved the allocated craft space will be forfeited.
